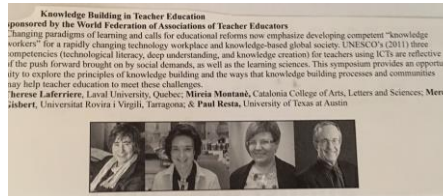

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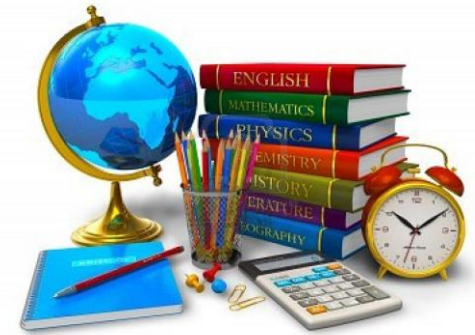

The 6th Biennial WFATE Conference will
be held in Houston, Texas, USA. The

held in early November 2020. Houston is
the 4th largest city in the USA with a
metro area population of almost 7
million people. Over 145 languages are
spoken in Houston and social justice is a
